



Moving Parents and Children Together Programme (M-PACT) is a whole family, structured support programme developed by the Forward Trust in 2006, which aims to improve the well-being of children and families affected by alcohol, or substance misuse.

This free programme is for families who have children aged 8 to 17 years old. It provides a safe, confidential space for parents, carers, and children to work together. Support is provided by friendly, non-judgemental staff from Sheffield Young Carers Project.

Sheffield Young Carers delivery the M-Pact programme under license of the Forward Trust and all staff involved have received specialist training.
